808.04 (7m) An appeal from a judgment or order terminating parental rights or denying termination of parental rights shall be initiated by filing the notice required by s. 809.107 (2) within 30 days after the date of entry of the judgment or order appealed from. This amendment incorporates the change requested by the SPD this morning. Accordingly, you should proceed with this amendment rather than with LRBa1846/1.

This amendment does all of the following:

- 1. Deletes the language that would have permitted a termination of parental rights to a child who is at risk of abuse or neglect when the parent is not likely to remedy the conditions leading to court intervention.
- 2. Permits a state-funded foster care and adoption resource center or a state-funded postadoption resource center to advertise for adoptions.
- 3. Permits the state adoption information exchange, the state adoption center, and a state-funded foster care and adoption resource center to provide preadoption preparation.
- 4. Permits the time for filing a notice of appeal, as well as a notice of intent to appeal, to be enlarged when the TPR petition was filed by a representative of the public interest.
