SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 717

January 24, 2006 - Offered by Committee on Judiciary, Corrections and Privacy.

1 AN ACT to amend 940.03 of the statutes; relating to: felony murder.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 940.03 of the statutes is amended to read:

940.03 Felony murder. Whoever causes the death of another human being while committing or attempting to commit a crime specified in s. <u>940.19</u>, <u>940.195</u>, <u>940.20</u>, <u>940.201</u>, <u>940.203</u>, <u>940.225</u> (1) or (2) (a), <u>940.30</u>, <u>940.31</u>, <u>943.02</u>, <u>943.10</u> (2), <u>943.23</u> (1g), or <u>943.32</u> (2) may be imprisoned for not more than 15 years in excess of the maximum term of imprisonment provided by law for that crime or attempt.
