SECTION 1. 36.11 (47) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
36.11 (47) ARMED FORCES. (intro.) If a student who is <u>a resident of Wisconsin</u>
and a member of a national guard or a member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed
forces withdraws from school after September 11, 2001, because he or she is called
into state active duty <u>under ch. 21</u> or into active service with the U.S. armed forces
for at least 30 days, the board shall <u>reenroll the student beginning in the semester</u>
following his or her discharge from active duty or the next succeeding semester.

September 11, 2001, because he or she is called into state active duty <u>under ch. 21</u>
or into active service with the U.S. armed forces for at least 30 days, the college or
university shall, at the student's request, grant <u>do all of the following:</u>

<u>(2)</u> Grant the student an incomplete in all <u>of</u> the courses <u>from which the student</u>
 <u>had to withdraw</u> and permit the student to complete the courses, within 6 months
 after leaving state service or active service, without paying additional tuition or fees.
