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**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 718**

December 13, 2005 – Offered by Representative WIECKERT.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 77.52 (2) (a) 2.; and *to create* 77.51 (4m), 77.51
2 (13s) and 77.52 (2) (a) 2. b. of the statutes; **relating to:** eliminating the
3 imposition of the sales tax on admissions sold by a gun club.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 77.51 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:

5 77.51 (4m) “Gun club” includes a trapshooting club, skeet–shooting club,
6 sporting–clay club, rifle and pistol club, sportsmen’s club, hunting club, rod and gun
7 club, hunting and fishing club, and conservation club. “Gun club” does not include
8 a wild animal farm or bird hunting preserve licensed under ch. 169.

9 **SECTION 2.** 77.51 (13s) of the statutes is created to read:

10 77.51 (13s) “Safety classes” means all classes approved by the department of
11 natural resources related to hunting, including hunting with a bow, and related to
12 firearms, all–terrain vehicles, boats, and snowmobiles.
