

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 864**

January 26, 2006 – Offered by Representative GRIGSBY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: after “circumstances” insert “, Medical Assistance
3 reimbursement, transferring funds to the Medical Assistance trust fund, increasing
4 low-income energy assistance, and making appropriations”.

5 **2.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 1e.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,
7 insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

8 **2005-06** **2006-07**

9 **20.505 Administration, department of**

10 (1) SUPERVISION AND MANAGEMENT

11 (dm) Low-income energy assistance GPR A 6,000,000 -0-

12 **SECTION 1m.** 20.505 (1) (dm) of the statutes is created to read:

1 20.505 (1) (dm) *Low-income energy assistance*. Annually, the amounts in the
2 schedule for low-income energy assistance under 2005 Wisconsin Act (this act),
3 section 1r (1).”.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 1: delete “**SECTION 1**” and substitute “**SECTION 1p**”.

5 **4.** Page 2, line 11: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 1r. Nonstatutory provisions.**”.

7 **5.** Page 2, line 15: after that line insert:

8 “(1) Notwithstanding section 16.27 (5) of the statutes, in fiscal year 2005–06,
9 a household with an annual income that does not exceed 206.7 percent of the federal
10 poverty line is eligible to receive low-income energy assistance under section 16.27
11 of the statutes. Notwithstanding section 16.27 (2), (3), and (6) of the statutes, the
12 department of administration shall pay low-income energy assistance benefits
13 under this subsection from the appropriation account under section 20.505 (1) (dm)
14 of the statutes, as created by this act.

15 **SECTION 2m. Appropriation changes.**

16 (1) **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE REIMBURSEMENT DECREASE.** In the schedule under
17 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of family
18 services under section 20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2005,
19 the dollar amount is decreased by \$63,500,000 for fiscal year 2005–06 and the dollar
20 amount is decreased by \$100,000 for fiscal year 2006–07 to decrease funding for the
21 purposes for which the appropriation is made.

22 (2) **TRANSFER FROM GENERAL FUND TO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TRUST FUND.** There is
23 transferred from the general fund to the Medical Assistance trust fund \$51,400,000
24 in fiscal year 2005–06 and \$25,300,000 in 2006–07.
