### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law relating to public health, the Department of Health and Family Services and local health departments annually issue permits to and otherwise regulate restaurants. A "restaurant" is defined to mean any building, room, or place where meals are prepared, served, or sold to transients or the general public. The definition has numerous exceptions, including free lunches from taverns; occasional meals prepared, served, or sold by churches, certain organizations, and service clubs; public or private school lunchrooms; stands at public farm sales; and licensed vending machines.

This bill expands the exceptions to the definition of "restaurant" under the public health laws to include potluck events, as defined in the bill.
