The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows: 3 **SECTION 1.** 230.17 (3) of the statutes is amended to read: 4 230.17 (3) When any position to be filled involves fiduciary responsibility, the 5 appointing authority, where shall conduct a criminal history background check 6 before offering employment to an applicant for the position. If otherwise permitted 7 by law, the appointing authority may require the appointee to furnish bond or other 8 security, and shall notify the administrator of the amount and other details thereof. 9 Any surety company authorized to do business in this state shall be a sufficient 10 security on any such bond.
