**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 345**

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 3, line 1: delete lines 1 to 12 and substitute:

3           “1. The owner subject to par. (b) had a license for a deer farm issued under s. 29.871,  
4           1999 stats., that was in effect on December 31, 2002, and that authorized persons other than  
5           the licensee or the licensee’s employees to hunt deer.

6           2. The owner complied with the requirement to register with the department under this  
7           section beginning on January 1, 2003 and has been registered continuously since then.

8           3. The deer are confined in an area that is not less than the acreage subject to the deer  
9           farm license on December 31, 2002.

10          4. Prior to January 1, 2003, the owner offered the opportunity to hunt as authorized  
11          under the license.

12          5. The owner submits to the department evidence that demonstrates that the owner  
13          meets the requirements of this paragraph, and the department verifies the evidence. The  
14          evidence related to subd. 4. may include any of the following:

15           a. A copy of the notice given by the owner to the department of natural resources prior  
16           to the taking of deer as required under s. 29.871 (7), 1999 stats.

17           b. The acknowledgement by the department of natural resources of the notice submitted  
18           by the owner prior to the taking of deer as required under s. 29.871 (7), 1999 stats.

19           c. The report submitted by the owner to the department of natural resources under s.  
20           29.871 (12), 1999 stats.

- 1 d. State or federal income tax records or sales tax records.  
2 e. A conditional use permit or other regulation imposed by a political subdivision.  
3 f. Receipts or other business records.  
4 g. Brochures, advertisements, Internet web sites, or other promotional information.

5 **SECTION 4m.** 95.55 (5) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

6 95.55 (5) (bm) An owner who wishes to demonstrate compliance with par. (bg) shall  
7 make application to the department no later than the first day of the sixth month after the  
8 effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date].”

9 **2.** Page 3, line 17: delete the material beginning with “minimum” and ending on page  
10 3, line 18 and substitute:

11 “acreage subject to the deer farm license on December 31, 2002.”.

**COMMENT:** Section 95.55 (5) (c) of the statutes requires DNR and  
DATCP to cooperate with respect to the hunting of farm-raised deer.
