## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This draft would expand the definition of "resident" for purposes of LTE and project appointments by state agencies. The definition is amended to include the minor child of a resident.

This change could slightly enlarge the potential applicant pool for LTE and project appointments. Thus, it could reduce state agency costs for placing employment ads to attract applicants. However, the amount of any savings from this draft is indeterminate, but probably very small.
