December 5, 2003 - Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 AN ACT to amend 15.915 (2) (a), 36.25 (13m) and 36.27 (2) (b) 3. of the statutes;  
2 relating to: membership of the State Laboratory of Hygiene Board;  
3 nonresident tuition exemption for veterans; and the transfer program at the  
4 University of Wisconsin Medical School (suggested as remedial legislation by  
5 the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System).

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

This bill changes the membership of the State Laboratory of Hygiene Board by substituting the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Madison for the president of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System. The bill also deletes obsolete references and clarifies the operation of the transfer program at the UW Medical School.

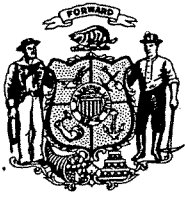
Current law grants nonresident tuition exemptions for the UW System to nonresident veterans who, among other things, were honorably discharged from military service within four years of registering at a UW institution. This bill changes the word "registering" to "applying."

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**BILL**

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

1 SECTION 1. 15.915 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 15.915 (2) (a) The president chancellor of the University of Wisconsin System  
3 Wisconsin-Madison, the secretary of health and family services, the secretary of  
4 natural resources and the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection,  
5 or their designees.

6 SECTION 2. 36.25 (13m) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 36.25 (13m) MEDICAL STUDENT TRANSFER PROGRAM. The board shall establish a  
8 program in the ~~Center for Health Sciences of the University of Wisconsin-Madison~~  
9 involving Wisconsin Medical School to consider the transfer of residents of this state  
10 from foreign medical schools after their 2nd year of study ~~or involving a 5th year of~~  
11 ~~elrkship following their completion of 4 years of study at a foreign school.~~

12 SECTION 3. 36.27 (2) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

13 36.27 (2) (b) 3. Nonresident persons who served in active duty in the U.S. armed  
14 forces for at least 10 years, who were honorably discharged from such service within  
15 4 years before ~~registering~~ applying at an institution, and who filed state income tax  
16 returns for at least 8 of the last 10 years of active duty in the U.S. armed forces, and  
17 their spouses and children are entitled to the exemption under par. (a).
