Under current law, certain types of vehicles may be registered for a period of consecutive months instead of for an annual or quarterly registration period. Consecutive monthly registration is for a minimum of three months, plus as many additional consecutive months as requested. Vehicles that may be registered on a consecutive monthly basis include motor trucks, trailers, and truck tractors used exclusively to transport concrete pipe or block, recycled metal salvage materials, logs or pulpwood, dirt, fill, or aggregates, or fresh milk. The fee for this type of registration is one—twelfth of the regular annual fee for the vehicle times the number of months for which the vehicle will be registered, plus a \$15 application charge.
