#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill would require the creation of web pages with an on-line reporting tool and search mechanism. A one-time appropriation of \$10,000 will fund the procurement of consultant services to create the necessary database, web pages and electronic reporting tools. Additional workload can be absorbed by current staffing.

The Ethics Board will develop web pages using asp.net technology. Based on consultant estimates, the Board estimates it will take approximately 150 hours to develop database tables and asp.net web pages that will be necessary. The Ethics Board will contract out services to an experienced asp.net programmer at an anticipated rate of between \$65 and \$74/hour.

The Board could also develop web pages that would display each vendor that bids for a contract and an electronic reporting tool for reporting that information. The one-time cost of developing database tables and asp.net web pages for this enhancement would be approximately \$55,000 (800 hours of programming X \$65-\$74/hour). The bill would permit but not require this enhancement.

Funding for the project could come from a charge to each state agency that posts a bid or proposal on the web site. The Departments of Administration and Transportation have informed the Board that those agencies create each year approximately 14,000 purchase orders valued at \$10,000 or more. The University of Wisconsin System and other state agencies may also post bids and proposals. In any case, a small filing fee for state agencies for each posting would cover the cost of web development.

#### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

In addition to a one-time cost for creating a database and web pages, the Ethics Board anticipates incurring annual costs for maintaining and improving the website. The Board estimates these costs will be approximately \$1,500/year for programming by a consultant.
