## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, a person is guilty of second degree sexual assault if 1) he or she has sexual contact with an individual who is under the influence of an intoxicant, 2) as a result of the intoxicant's effects, the victim is incapable of appraising the person's conduct, and 3) the person knows of the victim's condition. The current definition of an "intoxicant" excludes alcoholic beverages unless it is combined with a controlled substance, a controlled substance analog, or another drug. This bill amends the definition of "intoxicant" to include alcoholic beverages, whether or not combined with another substance.

The Department is unable to determine the number of offenders who will be found guilty of this crime. If an offender is found guilty, and sentenced to prison, the FY05 annual cost to house an inmate in a Department of Corrections prison was \$26,200. If the offender is placed on probation, the FY05 annual average cost of probation was \$2,031.

Local jail costs would also increase if any of the offenders are placed in jail awaiting disposition of the case, or sentenced to jail after conviction.
