6	act on the businesses community in this state, on the creation and growth of
7	businesses in this state, and on the economy of this state in general.
8	SECTION 115/ Effective dates. This act takes effect on January 1, 2008, except
9	as follows:
10	(1) Section 114m of this act takes effect on the day after publication.".
