## 2005 WISCONSIN ACT 445

AN ACT to renumber 118.019 (2m); to repeal and recreate 118.019 (2m) (title); and to create 118.019 (2m) (b) of the statutes; relating to: school district human growth and development programs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 118.019 (2m) (title) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

118.019 (2m) (title) REQUIRED SUBJECTS.

**SECTION 2.** 118.019 (2m) of the statutes is renumbered 118.019 (2m) (a).

**SECTION 3.** 118.019 (2m) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

118.019 (**2m**) (b) The school board shall ensure that instruction related to the areas under sub. (2) (e) does all

of the following:

- 1. Presents abstinence from sexual activity as the preferred choice of behavior in relationship to all sexual activity for unmarried pupils.
- 2. Emphasizes that abstinence from sexual activity before marriage is the most effective way to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, including human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome.

## **SECTION 4. Effective date.**

(1) This act takes effect on the July 1 after publication.
