Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a school board may provide an instructional program in human growth and development in grades kindergarten to 12. The program may include instruction in a number of areas, including self-esteem, interpersonal relationships, human sexuality, family life, and sex stereotypes. This bill provides that, if a school board provides instruction in human sexuality, reproduction, or family planning, it must ensure that all course materials and instruction do all of the following:

- 1. Present abstinence from sexual activity as the preferred choice of behavior in relationship to all sexual activity for unmarried pupils.
- 2. Devote more attention to abstinence from sexual activity than to any other behavior.
- 3. Emphasize that abstinence from sexual activity before marriage is the most effective way to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, including human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome.
- 4. If the curriculum includes instruction on the effectiveness of contraception or condoms, use actual effective rates instead of theoretical laboratory rates.
