

## **2005 SENATE BILL 286**

August 10, 2005 – Introduced by Senators Lazich, Grothman, Roessler, Leibham and Reynolds, cosponsored by Representatives Gundrum, Bies, Hines, Albers, Vos and Pridemore. Referred to Committee on Education.

AN ACT to renumber 118.019 (2m); to repeal and recreate 118.019 (2m) (title);

and to create 118.019 (2m) (b) of the statutes; relating to: school district

human growth and development programs.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a school board may provide an instructional program in human growth and development in grades kindergarten to 12. The program may include instruction in a number of areas, including self–esteem, interpersonal relationships, human sexuality, family life, and sex stereotypes. This bill provides that, if a school board provides instruction in human sexuality, reproduction, or family planning, it must ensure that all course materials and instruction do all of the following:

- 1. Present abstinence from sexual activity as the preferred choice of behavior in relationship to all sexual activity for unmarried pupils.
- 2. Devote more attention to abstinence from sexual activity than to any other behavior.
- 3. Emphasize that abstinence from sexual activity before marriage is the most effective way to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, including human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome.
