- 118.019 **(3)** (b) At the beginning of each school year, each school board that provides abstinence education, as defined in 42 USC 710 (b) (2), shall send a notice to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school district that includes the following statements:
- 9 1. The pupil will receive abstinence education.
- 2. Abstinence education does not teach pupils how to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections, such as human immunodeficiency virus and

- 1 acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, other than by remaining abstinent from
- 2 sexual activity.".
