Hi Peter:

Instead of amendment LRBa1045/1 to SB 286 that you drafted, could you just add on some language to 118.019(3) that requires:

Each school board that receives federal funding to provide a program of abstinence only education or that elects to provide such a program, shall, at the beginning of each school year, send a written notice to each pupil's parent or guardian that contains all of the following statements:

1. The pupil will receive abstinence only education
2. Abstinence only education does not teach pupils how to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections, such as human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, other than by remaining abstinent.

This language comes from another free-standing bill, LRB-3000/3.

*renumbered 118.019 (3)(a)*

3 "SECTION 3m. 118.019 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 ~~118.019 (3) DISTRIBUTION OF CURRICULUM TO PARENTS. Each school board that~~  
5 ~~provides an instructional program in human growth and development shall~~  
6 ~~annually provide the parents of each pupil enrolled in the school district with an~~  
7 ~~outline of the human growth and development curriculum used in the pupil's grade~~  
8 ~~level and information regarding how the parent may inspect the complete~~  
9 ~~curriculum and instructional materials, and information regarding how the parent~~  
10 ~~may exclude his or her child from the program or from specific subjects within the~~  
11 ~~program under sub. (4). The school board shall make the complete human growth~~
