TO 2005 SENATE BILL 286**

September 21, 2005 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber* 118.019 (2m); *to repeal and recreate* 118.019 (2m) (title);  
2             and *to create* 118.019 (2m) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** school district  
3             human growth and development programs.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4             **SECTION 1.** 118.019 (2m) (title) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:  
5             118.019 (2m) (title) REQUIRED SUBJECTS.

6             **SECTION 2.** 118.019 (2m) of the statutes is renumbered 118.019 (2m) (a).

7             **SECTION 3.** 118.019 (2m) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

8             118.019 (2m) (b) The school board shall ensure that instruction related to the  
9             areas under sub. (2) (e) does all of the following:

10            1. Presents abstinence from sexual activity as the preferred choice of behavior  
11            in relationship to all sexual activity for unmarried pupils.
