1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 3m. 118.019 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 118.019 (3) (a).

4 SECTION 3p. 118.019 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

5 118.019 (3) (b) At the beginning of each school year, each school board that
6 provides abstinence education, as defined in 42 USC 710 (b) (2), shall send a notice
7 to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school district that includes
8 the following statements:

9 1. The pupil will receive abstinence education.

10 2. Abstinence education does not teach pupils how to prevent pregnancy and
11 sexually transmitted infections, such as human immunodeficiency virus and

1 acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, other than by remaining abstinent from
2 sexual activity.”.
