Under current law, a person may not operate a vehicle, including a motorcycle, "on any highway of this state" unless the vehicle is registered or the vehicle is subject to specified exemptions. See s. 341.04 (1). I am unaware of any provision of the statutes that requires a motorcycle ridden exclusively off—road to be registered with DOT. Accordingly, I believe that, under current law, an unregistered off—the—road motorcycle may already be legally used for off—road promotional activities and filming. You may wish to confirm this interpretation of existing law with DOT or, if you prefer, I would be happy to do so.
