**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 290**

April 25, 2006 - Offered by Senator REYNOLDS.

1 **AN ACT to create** 146.25 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the required  
2 implanting of a microchip in an individual and providing a penalty.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This substitute amendment prohibits the requiring of an individual to undergo the implanting of a microchip and subjects a violator to a forfeiture of not more than \$10,000.

---

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 **SECTION 1.** 146.25 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **146.25 Required implanting of microchip prohibited.** (1) No person may  
5 require an individual to undergo the implanting of a microchip.

6 (2) Any person who violates sub. (1) may be required to forfeit not more than  
7 \$10,000. Each day of continued violation constitutes a separate offense.
