### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation prohibits elective state and local officials from soliciting money or any other thing of value or acting in concert with a person or committee acting independently of a candidate to influence a candidate election.

The State Elections Board and local filing officers will have to develop informational materials to share with elective officials to ensure they are aware of this restriction. District attorneys and the State Elections Board will incur costs to investigate and prosecute alleged violations of this provision.
