## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill makes several changes to state law regarding the definition of birth defects and the way in which birth defects of infants or children are reported to the Department's birth defect prevention and surveillance system.

This bill changes the process by which an infant or child's parent may decide not to consent to the release of that child's identifying information. The bill requires the Department, by January 1, 2007, to prescribe and distribute to pediatric specialty clinics and local health departments copies of a form that is to be used by a parent or guardian who decides to refuse to consent to the release of a identifying information about the child or to remove information from the birth defect system. The Department is required to remove this information from the system when the form requesting this action is received.

This provision would result in an increased workload which could not be absorbed. An additional 1.0 FTE Program and Planning Analyst would be needed to carry out the provisions of this bill. The position would have to develop and send out the new form, review forms that are returned, periodically review with providers the use of the form, and ensure that information is removed from the system as required by the form. The cost of an additional staff person would be \$63,300 GPR annually. Costs for printing and distributing the form would be \$500 GPR annually. Total costs of this bill to the Department are estimated to be \$63,800 annually.
