Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

WI Stat. 20.380 (2) (r) has created a sum sufficient, SEG (Conservation Fund) appropriation to pay the Aids in Lieu of Taxes that this bill refers to. If the 2007 payment takes into account the value of the new Kickapoo Valley Reserve Visitor Center, the Town of Stark's equalized valuation of real property will be more. It is unclear how much the DOR will adjust the valuation due to the new Center, but an increase in the valuation will also mean an increase in the Aids payment. The increased cost of the Aids could not be absorbed within current budget allotments.

The Town of Stark would realize increased revenues due to using the new Visitor Center to figure the 2007 Aids payment.
