Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This estimate is limited to an estimate of the fiscal effect of this bill on the Legislative Fiscal Bureau. Under the bill, the Legislative Fiscal Bureau would be required to submit to the Joint Committee on State Mandates (that would be created by this bill) by May 1, 2007, an identification of every state mandate, other than mandates having a minimal fiscal effect, that was in existence on the effective date of the bill. Assuming the bill were to be enacted sometime in the 2005-06 legislative session, the Legislative Fiscal Bureau believes that existing staff could be temporarily reallocated to complete this one-time activity.
