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Subject Fetal pain		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to include, in the information it currently prints and provides to county departments and physicians, several statements concerning pain experiences by a fetus at 20 weeks and concerning different methods of abortion. Under the bill, the Department may maintain an internet web site to provide the materials it is also required to print and distributed. The Department currently contracts with a provider to maintain a hotline that provides information on abortions.

Under this bill, the Department will have to revise material it currently prints and distributes. The Department estimates that the cost of developing the new material for distribution will be \$53,000 GPR. Included in this estimate is \$25,000 for medical consultation, \$10,000 for the required photo imaging and formatting of the material, \$15,000 for an initial printing and distribution, and \$2,000 for printing and mailing costs associated with information provided to physicians and county departments. Also included in this estimate is \$1,000 to translate the information into Spanish.

The Department revises the existing brochure periodically to reflect updated medical information and procedures. The additional cost of updating and maintaining this information is estimated at \$7,000 GPR annually. Included in this estimate is \$5,000 for medical consultation related to content updates, \$1,000 for the translation of new material, and \$1,000 for increased postage costs. In addition, the Department will need to expand the existing telephone hotline contract by \$10,000 per year to respond to additional inquiries that will result from the new information in the brochure. The total increase in costs for the Department as a result of this bill will be \$17,000 annually. These costs cannot be absorbed by the Department.
