Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill summary: This bill provides that if the Department of Natural Resources establishes an open season for fishing with a bow and arrow on a particular body of water, DNR must allow fishing with a bow and arrow on that body of water from sunset to sunrise during that open season.

Under current Department rules, fishing with a bow and arrow between sunset and sunrise is permitted on selected, but not all, waters where there is an open season.

Fiscal estimate: The Department anticipates an annual fiscal impact of approximately \$16,000 in the form of increased workload and travel expense for law enforcement personnel responding to calls regarding suspicious night time activity.

Assuming approximately 200 complaints (approximately 3 per county) per year specifically related to fishing with a bow and arrow between sunset and sunrise and two hours of law enforcement response time per complaint plus associated travel costs (average 30 miles per round trip), annual fiscal impact would be approximately \$14,000 in salary and fringe and \$2,000 in travel costs.

Additional cost to county sheriff departments are anticipated, as these departments are the likely recipients of initial calls regarding unusual night time activity on State waters. An estimate of \$3,000 annually is based on the assumption that county sheriff departments will be first responders to one-third of all calls.
