Subject Repeal the comprehensive planning (Smart Growth) statute		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law local governmental units with designated planning agencies or commissions are required to have a comprehensive plan for physical development and land use. Under the Smart Growth statute the comprehensive plan must contain certain planning elements such as housing, transportation, utilities and community facilities. This bill repeals the Smart Growth statute.

This change would not have a fiscal effect on DHFS or on county human services and social services departments.
