Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands current laws that authorize physicians to act under specified circumstances and to affect individuals by these authorized actions, by similarly authorizing advanced practice nurse prescribers and individuals licensed as physician assistants. With respect to approving therapeutic alternate drug selections and exempting pharmacists from certain requirements related to dispensing drug product equivalents, the bill authorizes an advanced practice nurse prescriber to act only if the advanced practice nurse prescriber has entered into a written agreement to collaborate with a physician.

This bill will require the Department of Regulation and Licensing [DRL], the Pharmacy Examining Board, the Medical Examining Board, and the Board of Nursing to amend existing rules to add the new authorities. DRL will incur one-time costs of \$5,720 to amend Administrative Rules and \$26,663 annual costs to enforce these provisions.
