Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

On 10/11/05, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), Office of Chief Counsel, indicated that a proposed substitute amendment to AB-342 (later introduced in bill form as AB-762) was "completely consistent with Federal law and would not endanger the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP) grants otherwise available to the State of Wisconsin." It is assumed that no changes were made to the bill draft following FMCSA review.
