#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Passage of this legislation will require the department to update its overtime regulations to reflect the changes included in the legislation. The department anticipates those changes can be made at very little cost using current staff.

To minimize printing costs the department will update its overtime brochure when current supplies of that brochure are exhausted.

Within the past six years the department has received two overtime complaints involving commercial businesses that utilize companion care workers. The department anticipates the volume of future complaints will remain about the same and the amount of work involved in investigating those complaints will be about 8-10 hours per complaint. The department believes it can absorb this amount of work without additional resources.
