Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands the categories of persons for whom a municipality may be required to pay litigation expenses. Under the bill, emergency medical services technicians, first responders under s. 146.50(1(e) to (hm), fire fighters and law enforcement or correctional officers would, except under certain circumstances enumerated in the bill, be eligible to receive payment for litigation expenses. It is impossible to predict the exact fiscal impact of this bill because it can vary depending on how many actions require payment of litigation expenses and which municipality is required to make the payment.
