Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law requires the Legislative Council staff to create and maintain an Internet site that includes a copy of each proposed rule received that it receives for review. The site must be searchable and also must include a section devoted to proposed rules affecting small businesses. The Legislative Council staff has created and is maintaining the site.

Senate Bill 150 provides for an alternative to current law by stating that the Internet site may provide a link to each proposed rule and a link to a site that identifies proposed rules affecting small businesses. The cost of providing these links can be absorbed in the current budget of the Legislative Council staff.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
