Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a requirement that notice be given to persons in situations in which personal information about them is acquired by someone who has not been authorized to receive the personal information.

This fiscal estimate addresses the original bill but takes note the author of the bill introduced Senate Substitute Amendment 1 on September 19, 2005. The comments contained in this estimate apply equally to both the original and the substitute amendment.

It appears most records maintained by the court system meet the definition of "publicly available information" contained in the bill. Therefore, those records are exempted from the notice requirement under the definition of "personal information."

Certain court records contain personal information as defined in the bill. If the record-keeping systems of the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) or of the Clerk of Courts offices designed to keep that information private were breached, then it is possible the notice requirement of the bill would apply.

An accurate estimate of the increased costs is impossible with existing data.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
