Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Substitute Amendment to 2005 Senate Bill 221

ASSUMPTIONS USED IN ARRIVING AT FISCAL ESTIMATE

Under SB 221 DWD is required to draft a rule to implement an administrative rule requiring training in shaken baby syndrome (SBS) for all certified providers who provide care and supervision for children under five years of age.

Assumptions:

- *DHFS is the lead agency in determining required training and establishing administrative rules for shaken baby syndrome (SBS).
- *DHFS has up to 12 months to prepare the training materials
- *As much as practical DWD will mirror DHFS licensed day care requirements for our certified providers and consult with the child abuse and neglect prevention board.
- *This bill requires SBS training for both current providers and those who apply to be providers and will care for children under age five years.
- * The length of certification is 24 months with 1/24th of all current providers needing to be recertified each month.
- *There is sufficient time to train all current providers and providers who have applied for certification in SBS within the 18 months effective date of this bill.
- *Current providers requesting recertification prior to the DHFS training being available or scheduled for recertification after the 18 months effective date would offered classroom training of approximately 1 hour and added to the SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome) training. The SBS training cost is \$10 per provider.
- *Face-to-face SBS training for the current providers requesting recertification after the training materials are available and during the 18 months prior the to the effective date would be about one-half hour, use DHFS training materials, and have an average cost of \$10 per recertification review.
- *DWD has 4700 providers currently certified to care for a child under age five.
- *DWD adds approximately 1149 new certified providers annually.
- *Rule development can be done with existing staff.
- * Certified and licensed providers will be notified by inserts with their subsidy checks at minimal additional costs.
- * The counties as the certifying agencies will need to provide SBS training due to insufficient funds for Child Care Resource and Referral agencies.
- * The one time cost of training current provides is \$47,000.
- * The ongoing annual costs of training providers requesting certification is \$11,490.
