Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

This bill clarifies that the specific total vehicle noise level standards in current law apply only to new snowmobiles. The bill also creates separate noise level standards for exhaust and engine noise.

This bill would provide law enforcement a method to test snowmobile noise while the snowmobile is in the stationary position. It would create a definitive decibel level, and anyone operating above this level would automatically be in violation of state law.

State Fiscal Estimate:

Enforcement of noise laws using the proposed procedure and administration of the procedure will be absorbed into existing noise enforcement practices by the Department. Citation authority for sound enforcement already exists and will be shifted to the new procedure without an increase in costs. Equipment specified for use in the proposed rule already exists within the Department's law enforcement program. Sixty conservation wardens have already been trained on the procedures outlined in the proposed rule.

Local Fiscal Estimate:

County law enforcement officers are expected to receive training on the procedure at a Department-required training session. Any equipment necessary for testing snowmobile noise can be purchased and submitted for county reimbursement through the "law enforcement aids to counties" grant program.
