Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 398 would require the Department of Commerce to establish fire safety standards that all cigarettes sold or offered for sale in this state must meet. Every cigarette manufacturer that seeks to permit cigarettes it manufactures to be sold in the state must certify to the department that the cigarettes meet these standards. Each certification must be forwarded to the Department of Justice. The manufacturer must provide a copy of the certification to wholesale providers. The Department must establish a procedure by which persons who sell cigarettes at retail and cigarette vending machine operators in this state may obtain notification of which cigarettes are the subject of a certification.

The workload associated with SB 398 can be absorbed within current resources. This workload would include promulgation of fire safety standards for cigarettes, establishing a system by which retailers know which cigarettes are the subject of a certification, and processing of certifications submitted by manufacturers. There are currently approximately 36 manufacturers whose cigarettes are offered for sale in Wisconsin. The Department estimates that revenue associated with submittal of certifications would be minimal.
