Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would make a wide variety of changes in the sentencing process in Wisconsin. In some cases it would lower the minimum sentences, which would increase the likelihood of plea bargaining. In other cases it would raise the maximum sentence which would increase the likelihood of a request for a trial. It is impossible to know up front how it would on net impact the workload of district attorneys offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The actual impact of the bill should be monitored closely to determine what if any net impact it caused and if additional prosecutorial resources are needed.
