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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill does the following: 1) makes changes regarding mail theft and identify theft; 2) makes changes regarding the use of social security numbers by businesses and employers; and 3) allows individuals to restrict access to their credit reports.

Currently, the Department solicits social security numbers to check a potential employee's tax compliance history. This bill would disallow that.

The bill allows a credit reporting agency to release a credit report to the Department of Revenue for purposes of collecting delinquent taxes.

This bill has no significant fiscal effect.
