Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2005 SB 601 would require the Department of Commerce to include particular information on the standard forms the Department utilizes for 1&2 family dwelling permits. These forms are also utilized by municipalities who administer the 1&2 family dwelling code in their municipality. Specifically, 2005 SB 601 would require that the use of insulating concrete forms be indicated on the form.

This requirement would not result in additional expenditures or revenues for the Department, and would therefore have no fiscal impact on the Department. There would also be no fiscal impact on municipalities.
