### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

#### BILL SUMMARY:

This bill makes many technical changes to commercial driver training statutes, administered by the Department of Transportation under chapter 343.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- This bill will not impact the number of driver training schools.
- This bill will not impact total revenue collected for licensing driver training schools and instructors. This bill allows the department to issue a license for up to 24 months, however, the annual license fee of \$95 remains. As such, the department would collect \$190 for a license issued for two years.

#### COST SUMMARY:

\$3360 ongoing revenue increase

#### BASIS FOR COST SUMMARY:

This bill adds a \$10 fee for any changes to a driver school license and a \$10 fee for every mailing address where one or more driver school classrooms are located. It is estimated that 96 licenses will be changed annually, and 240 additional classroom licenses will be issued.

$$96 + 240 = 336 * \$10 = \$3360$$

Manuals and forms can be revised on their normal schedule. No additional costs will be incurred.

Additional revenues from increased penalties are indeterminate.

No programming changes are needed.
