Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a school board must give a teacher a written notice of renewal or refusal to renew the teacher's contract for the following school year. This statutory renewal provision may be modified, waived, or replaced by a collective bargaining agreement.

This bill provides that the term of each teacher's employment contract is limited to one year, until the teacher has been continuously employed for five years, at which point the term of the contract becomes two years. This bill also prohibits the nonrenewal of a contract for arbitrary or capricious reasons.

State Fiscal Effect:

This bill will have no state fiscal effect.

Local Fiscal Effect:

Under this bill, a school district's costs may increase or decrease depending on the salaries of teachers the school district retains, terminates, and/or hires. Therefore, the local fiscal effect of this bill is indeterminate.
