## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates a Manufacturing Competitiveness Grant and Loan Program within the Department and appropriates \$1,500,000 GPR in one-time funds for awards. The bill defines eligible recipients as the University of Wisconsin System, the Technical College Board and certain tax-exempt organizations that provide specialized assistance to manufacturers. The bill defines eligible projects, and requires the Department to define by emergency rules certain activities under the program. In addition, the bill creates a 27-member Manufacturing Competitiveness Council attached to the Department whose primary activity is to advise the Department in awarding grants and loans under this program.

The Department anticipates that it may absorb the additional workload associated with this bill within its current resources. However, the Department does not anticipate that it can absorb the costs of the council within its existing GPR supplies and services allocation.

Depending on the demand for funds and timing of applications, the Department anticipates no fewer than four Council meetings in a given calendar year. The Department estimates a variety of costs associated with the activities of the Council to include:

Coordinating, scheduling and facilitating meetings; Mailing, printing and material development costs; Telephone and/or videoconferencing; Expense reimbursement;

The Department anticipates travel related expenditures only for 13 of the proposed 27 council members. The Department anticipates the need to reimburse for mileage incurred plus lunch expenses. These costs are estimated below.

**Annual Council Costs:** 

Telephone and videoconferencing: \$1,200

Mailing, printing and material development costs: \$1,500

Board Member Expenditures: \$5,000

Total Annual Council Costs: \$7,700
