Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assumptions would be that no new schools are formed and no school enrollment increases. During academic year 2004-05 98 more students could have been awarded the scholarship. In academic year 2003-04 81 more students could have been awarded the scholarship. In academic year 2002-03 82 more students could have been awarded the scholarship. Based on this three year average of 87 more students receiving the scholarship, additional dollars would be needed to fund the appropriation of \$97,875 per year.
