2005 Wisconsin Act 223
[2005 Senate Bill 324]

**Transporting Certain Pupils
to School**

Current law in s. 121.545 (1) of the statutes, provides that the parent of a pupil who is not required to be transferred to and from a public or private school may agree to pay the school board of the school district a sufficient fee to reimburse the school board for the cost of providing the transportation, in which case the school board may transport the pupil.

2005 Wisconsin Act 223 allows a school board to charge a fee for this transportation and to waive the fee or any portion of it for any person who is unable to pay.

Initial Applicability: The Act first applies to the transportation of pupils in the 2006 school year.
