



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2005 Assembly Bill 567**

**2005 Assembly Bill 567** revises the current prohibitions against inattentive driving and creates a new prohibition. The revised prohibition in s. 346.89 (2), Stats., and the new prohibition created in the bill [s. 346.89 (3)] contain an exception relating to global positioning systems (GPS), providing that the prohibitions do not apply to any GPS device “installed or mounted” in the vehicle.

**Assembly Amendment 1** specifies that the GPS device may be either “**permanently or temporarily**” installed or mounted in the vehicle.

### **Legislative History**

On December 7, 2005, the Assembly Committee on Highway Safety recommended passage of the bill, as amended by Assembly Amendment 1, both on a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 0.
