## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the requiring of an individual to undergo the implanting of a microchip and subjects a violator to a forfeiture of not more than \$10,000.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 146.25 of the statutes is created to read:

- 4 **146.25 Required implanting of microchip prohibited.** (1) No person may
- 5 require an individual to undergo the implanting of a microchip.
- 6 (2) Any person who violates sub. (1) may be required to forfeit not more than
- 7 \$10,000. Each day of continued violation constitutes a separate offense.
