



2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 471

June 9, 2005 - Introduced by Representative SCHNEIDER. Referred to Committee on Health.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 134.85 of the statutes; **relating to:** gender discrimination in
2 prescription drug pricing.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a person engaged in selling or dispensing prescription drugs from discriminating in price between purchasers of a drug on the basis of the gender of the purchasers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 134.85 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **134.85 Gender discrimination in prescription drug pricing.** (1) In this
5 section, "drug" means any substance subject to 21 USC 353(b).

6 (2) No person who sells or dispenses drugs may discriminate in price between
7 purchasers of a drug on the basis of the gender of the purchasers.

8 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**
